RULES FOR PLURAL NOUNS

For most nouns, simply add -s

car - cars

cat - cats

house - houses

student – students

bag – bags

book - books

table - tables

horse – horses

place – places

For nouns ending in -s, -ss, -ch, -x, -z, or -o, add -es

bus - buses boss - bosses coach - coaches box - boxes

buzz - buzzes potato - potatoes

*Exception: With nouns ending with -s or -z, the last letter may be doubled before adding -es.

gas – gasses quiz – quizzes

*Exception: With nouns ending in -o, at times you simply add -s photo – photos

piano – pianos

taco - tacos

For nouns ending in -f or -fe, change the ending to -ves

wolf - wolves scarf - scarves knife - knives

*Exception:

At times a noun ending with -f will not change and simply take -s

roof - roofs

chef - chefs

For nouns ending in a consonant followed by -y, change the ending to -ies

```
city - cities
sky - skies
puppy - puppies
```

*Note:

```
If the final -y is preceded by a vowel, simply add -s
day - days
joy - joys
boy - boys
```

For nouns ending with -us, the plural ending is often -i

cactus - cacti octopus - octopi focus - foci

For nouns ending with -is, the plural ending is -es

crisis - crises analysis - analyses ellipsis - ellipses

For nouns ending with -on, the plural ending is -a criterion - criteria phenomenon - phenomena

Some nouns don't change at all

sheep - sheep series - series offspring - offspring deer — deer fish - fish moose - moose shrimp - shrimp tuna - tuna

You will need to memorize these nouns

man - men woman - women child - children person - people foot - feet tooth - teeth goose - geese mouse - mice dice - die
